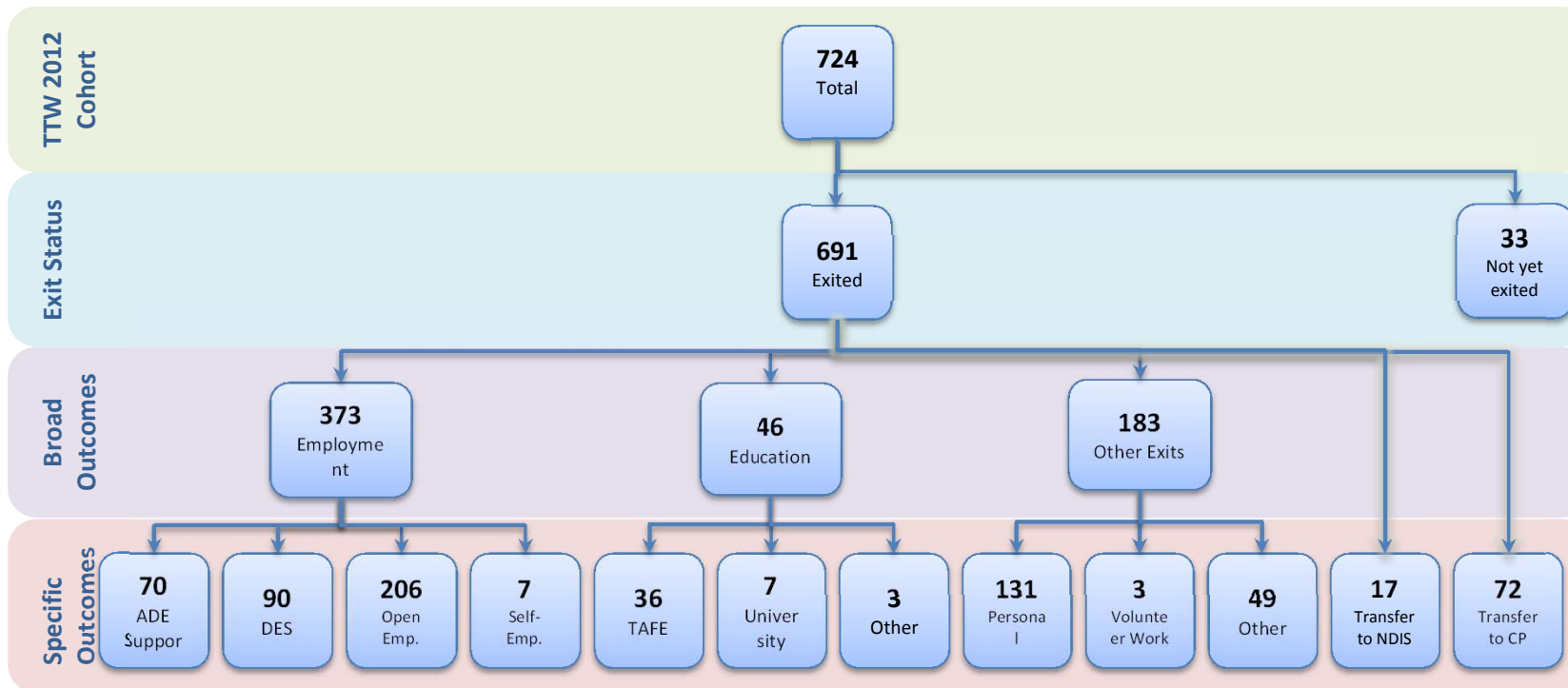
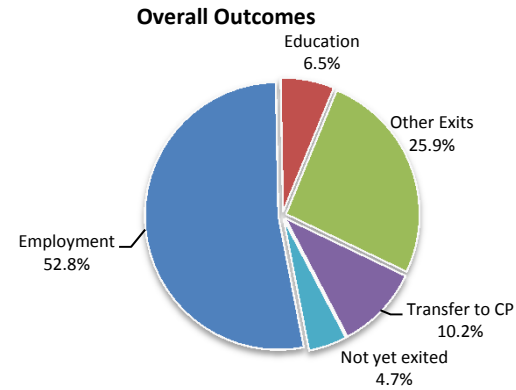

5. CP (Community Participation) - provides life skills supports and community access for people with disability

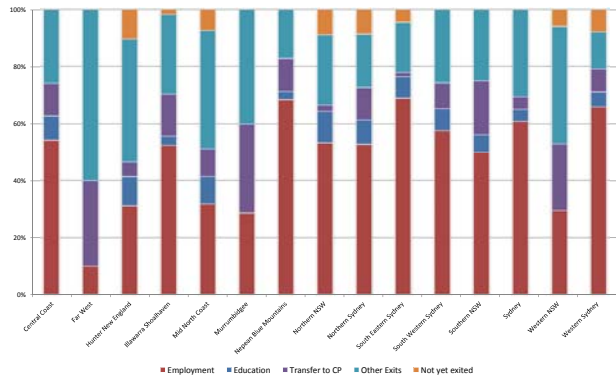

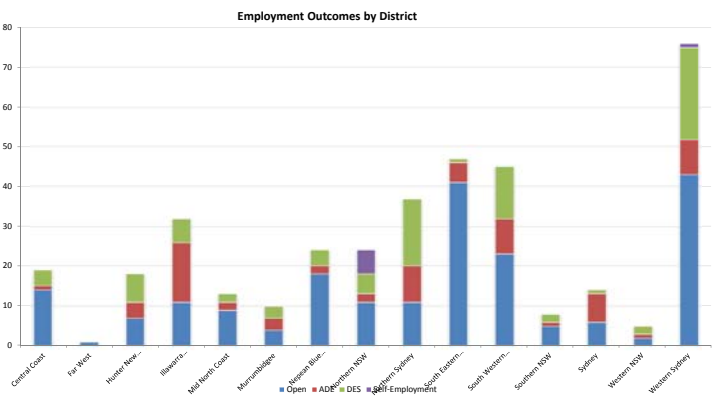

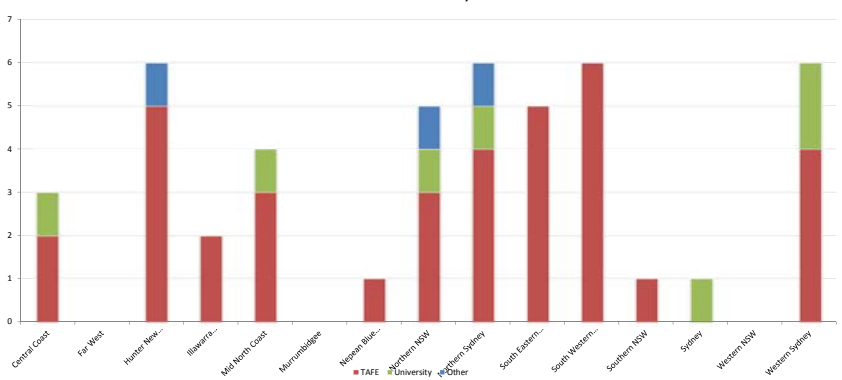

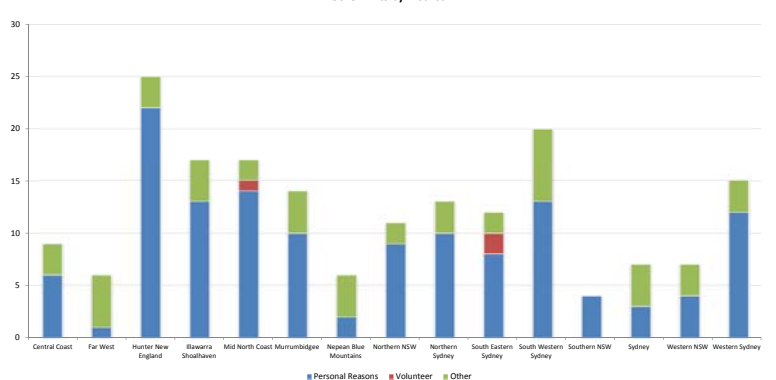

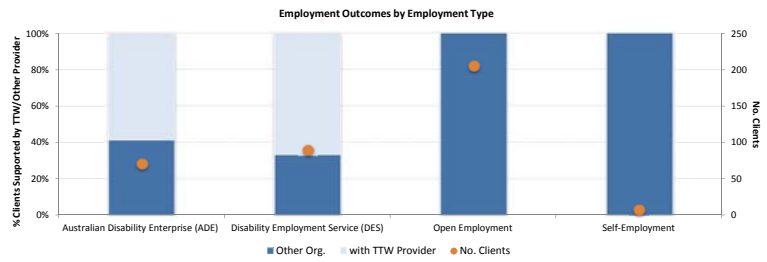
Other Exits by District



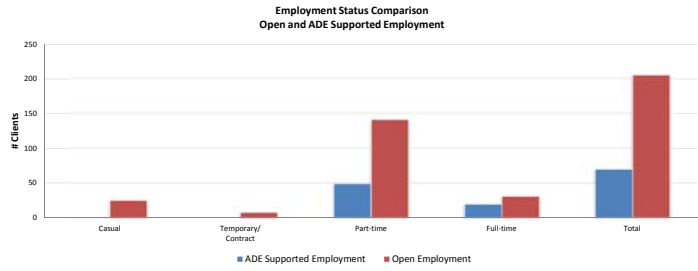

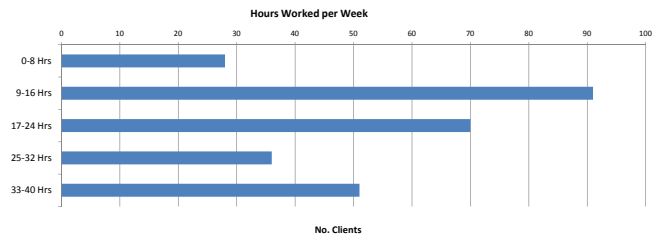

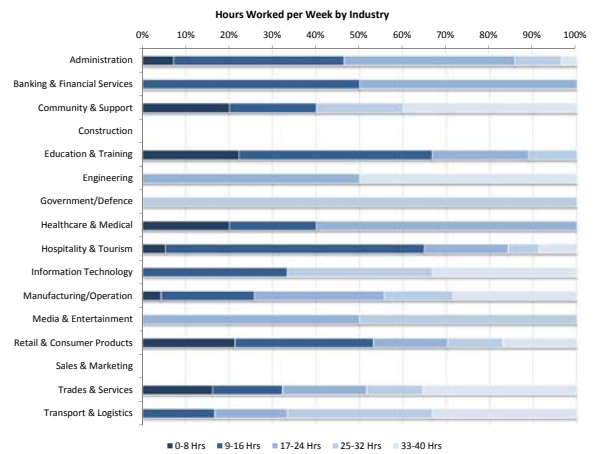
